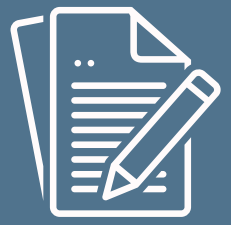
FCFA was the largest single investment in improving understanding of Africa's climate
